Related Information

The Organic Statute of the Ministry of Finance, as approved by the Decree-Law no. 13/2009, dated 25 February, created the central services under the direct administration of the State within the scope of the Ministry of Finance, including *inter alia* the Directorate-General of Revenue and Customs. In view of this, and in conformity with article 24 of Decree-Law no. 13/2009, it is necessary to approve its organic and functional structure. The Ministerial Diploma No. 13/2009, of 25 February 2009 establishes organic and functional structure for the Directorate-General of Revenue and Customs under the Ministry of Finance

General Directorate of Revenue and Customs has currently 320 staff. 119 out of 320 are temporary staff. The General Directorate of Revenue and Customs is supervised by a Director-General, who is appointed by the Minister of Finance according to the law. The Director-General reports directly to the Minister of Finance. The Director-General is replaced in his/her absences and impediments by a National Director within the scope of the General Directorate of Revenue and Customs, appointed by the Minister of Finance and under proposal of the Director-General.

This General Directorate consists of three National Directorates:

- National Directorate of Customs;
- National Directorate of Petroleum Revenues;
- National Directorate of Domestic Tax;

The General Directorate of Revenue and Customs also includes the following additional Departments:

- Department of Legal Counsel;
- Department of Administration;

According to the current organizational structure of the General Directorate of Revenue and Customs, the following two Sections report directly to the Director General:

- Executive Support, Liaison Office & Complaints
- Internal Audit & Ethical Standards.
